Dr. Sanjiv Misra has a Master of Public Administration degree from the John F. Kennedy School of Government, Harvard University, USA where he was an Edward S. Mason Fellow between 1986 and 1987. He also has a Post-graduate degree in Economics from the Delhi School of Economics and a Ph.D in the 'Political Economy of International Oil' from the Jawahar Lal Nehru University, New Delhi.

Dr. Misra has been a member of the Indian Administrative Service from July, 1972 to March, 2008. During this period he held various senior level positions in Government of India as well as in the State Government of Gujarat, including:

Dr. Misra was awarded the prestigious Lucius N. Littauer Fellowship for academic excellence at the John F. Kennedy School of Government, Harvard University, USA in 1987.

Dr. Misra has also been a Senior Fellow at the Centre for Policy Research, New Delhi and lectured in Economics at St. Stephen's College, University of Delhi, prior to joining the IAS.

Dr. Misra has authored a book entitled "India's Textile Sector – A Policy Analysis" in 1991 [Sage Publications, New Delhi] and several papers.
